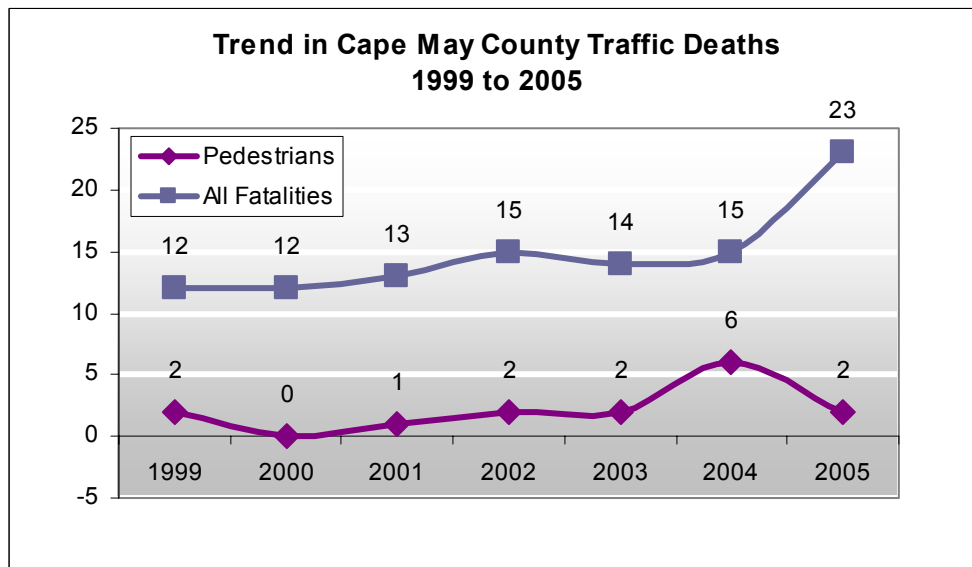


Traffic Deaths in Cape May County

Speeding and Reckless Driving in Cape May County

Speeding- and reckless driving-related fatalities (1999-2004): 42

Total traffic fatalities for which cause was recorded (1999-2004): 64

Percentage of total traffic fatalities that were caused by speeding or reckless driving (1999-2004): 65.6%

Statewide rank: 9

Data source: TSTC analysis of National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS) database, 1999 through 2004. Includes speeding, failing to obey traffic signals or signs, failure to yield, improper lane changes, and other forms of reckless driving.

Total pedestrians fatalities (1999-2005): 15

Total traffic fatalities (1999-2005): 104

Percentage of total traffic fatalities that were pedestrians (1999-2005): 14.4%
