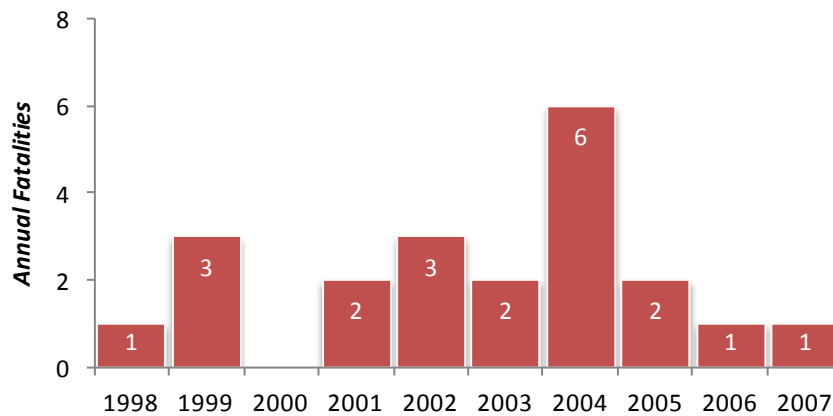


Skimping on Sidewalks in Cape May County
