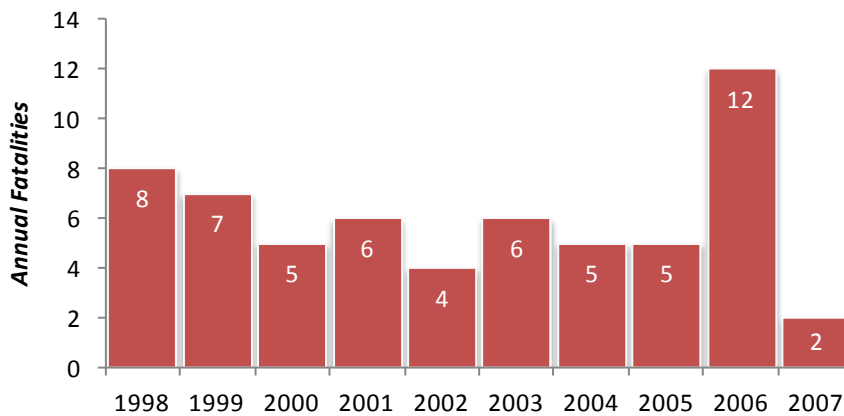


Skimping on Sidewalks in Morris County
