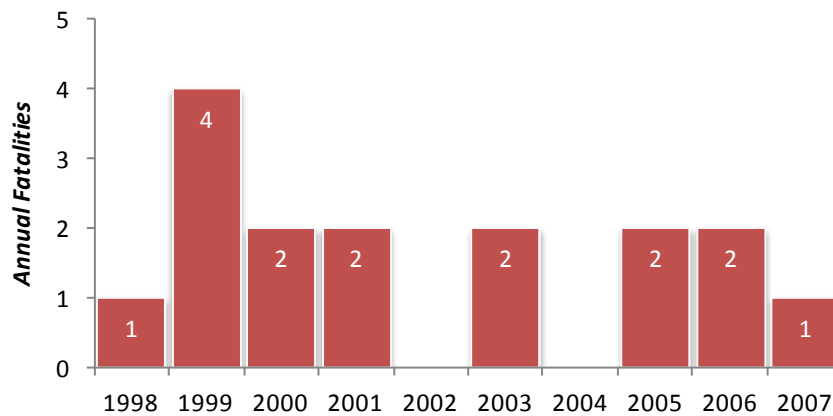


Skimping on Sidewalks in Salem County
